About St. Mary's School for the Deaf

St. Mary's School for the Deaf (SMSD) is a private, state-supported school that serves deaf, hard of hearing and functionally deaf children from infancy through age 21. There is no tuition charge for New York State residents.

SMSD has been the primary source of quality education utilizing the full spectrum of communication modes since 1853.

Activities

Students and families are given a variety of programs to choose from. Some of the activities include:

These community and campus experiences include participation with students from other mainstream programs.

Transportation
