Dear SMSD Community:

The health and safety of our students and staff is our top priority. With that in mind, the purpose of this letter is to inform you that we just were notified of an individual at St. Mary's School for the Deaf who has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual was last present on Wednesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

In working with the Health Department, we are taking all the recommended steps to ensure the safety of our students and staff. Steps we are implementing in cooperation with the DOH include the following:

- This individual and any individuals identified by the Erie County Department of Health as being close contacts have already been informed and are expected to follow the ECDOH's quarantine/isolation guidelines as directed by the ECDOH.

St. Mary's School for the Deaf cannot release any further details due to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Health Insurance Portability & Accounting Act (HIPAA) requirements. Please continue to monitor your child for symptoms and have him/her stay home if they are sick. In addition, please contact your child's healthcare provider if they develop symptoms or if you have any additional questions or concerns.
